A BILL

To amend the law relating to trade unions; and to amend the Trade Union Act, 1881.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Trade Union short sitle. (Amendment) Act, 1918."

The Trade Union Act, 1881, is hereinafter referred to

as the Principal Act.

- 2. (1) Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is Change of amended by omitting the words "not less than two-name. thirds of the total number of members" and inserting Sec. 21 of Principal in their place the words "the members, obtained in Act. accordance with its rules."
- (2) Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is Amalgama-amended by omitting the words "not less than two-sec. 22 of thirds of the members" and inserting in their place the Principal words "a majority of the total number of members." Act:
