A BILL

To fix the rates of tax to be collected upon motor omnibuses and other public motor vehicles registered under the provisions of the Transport Act, 1929; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Transport Short title. (Public Motor Vehicles) Tax Act, 1929," and shall be read and construed with the Transport Act, 1929.

(2) This Act shall commence upon the date ap-Commence-pointed for the commencement of the Transport Act, ment. 1929.

2. There shall be collected under the Transport Act, Taxation. 1929, in the year one thousand nine hundred and twentynine and in each succeeding year at the times prescribed by that Act or the regulations made thereunder and subject to the provisions of that Act, from every owner of a public motor vehicle owned or registered by a Trust under that Act, and in respect of each such vehicle for the use of His Majesty and for credit of the Public Vehicles Fund, taxes at the rates set out in the Schedule to this Act in lieu of the tax to which such vehicle is subject under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1924.

3. For the purposes of this Act—

Weight.

- (a) the weight of a vehicle shall be ascertained as the gross weight of the vehicle laden with tools and accessories usually carried, with such fuel, water, and oil as may be in or upon the vehicle but otherwise unladen:
- (b) the number of one-half hundredweights nearest to the weight so ascertained shall be the weight upon which the tax is to be collected.

SCHEDULE.

1. VEHICLE RATE.

- (a) Upon every motor omnibus with pneumatic tyres.

- (b) Upon every motor omnibus with any non-pneumatic or solid tyre.
- weight of its weight.

2s. 9d. per half hundred-

- (c) Upon every other public motor vehicle with pneumatic tyres.
- 2s. 9d. per half hundredweight of its weight.
- (d) Upon every other motor vehicle with any non-pneumatic or solid tyre.
- 3s. 6d. per half hundredweight of its weight.

Any vehicle which in the opinion of the Commissioner of Road Transport is almost wholly manufactured within the British Empire shall be charged according to the above scale less a deduction of sixpence per half hundredweight of the weight of the vehicle.

2. Passenger Rate.

In addition to tax at the above vehicle rate there shall be paid tax according to the following Passenger Rate:—

- (a) Upon every motor omnibus £1 10s. per passenger. registered to carry not more than twenty passengers.
- (b) Upon every motor omnibus £2 per passenger. registered to carry more than twenty passengers.
