Truck (Amendment) Bill, 1928.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to amend the Truck Act of 1900 in order to facilitate the reprint under the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1906, of the Truck Act, 1900, as amended by subsequent Acts, and to give effect to the obvious intention of the amending Acts.

A BILL

To amend the Truck Act of 1900; and to repeal the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901, and the Truck (Amendment) Act, 1918.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Truck (Amend- Short title.
ment) Act, 1928."

2. The Truck Act of 1900 is amended—

(a) by omitting from section ten all the words which were inserted in that section by the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901, and the Truck (Amendment) Act, 1918;

(b) by inserting at the end of paragraph one of section ten the words “or where an employer or his agent deducts from the wages due to any workman the amount of a voluntary donation or subscription to a hospital fund, or to a medical guarantee fund.
