A BILL

To amend the Trustees of Schools of Arts Enabling Act, 1902, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Trustees of Schools of Arts Enabling (Amendment) Act, 1942." Short title and citation.

(2) The Trustees of Schools of Arts Enabling Act, 1902, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Trustees of Schools of Arts Enabling Act, 1902-1942.

2. The Trustees of Schools of Arts Enabling Act, 1902, is amended—

5 (a) by inserting at the end of the definition of "Institution" in section three the words "and includes any such institution established, provided, conducted or carried on under a special Act";

Sec. 3. (Definition.)

(b) by omitting section four and by inserting in lieu thereof the following section:—

10 4. (1) The provisions of this Act shall extend to and in respect of an institution established, provided, conducted or carried on under a special Act.

Application of Act to institutions operating under special Acts.

15 (2) The powers conferred by this Act shall, in their application to and in respect of any such institution, be in addition to and not in derogation of any powers conferred by or exercisable under the special Act.
