A BILL

To make further provisions to prevent the misleading use of forms resembling court process; to amend the Unauthorised Documents Act, 1922; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Unauthorised Documents (Amendment) Act, 1934." Short title.

(2) The Unauthorised Documents Act, 1922, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Unauthorised Documents Act, 1922-1934.

2. The Unauthorised Documents Act, 1922, is amended by inserting at the end of paragraph (b) of section four the following word and new paragraph:—

- (c) in issuing any notification relating to proceedings or intended proceedings for the recovery of any debt or in making demand for the payment of any money uses any document or form which is a colourable imitation of any document or form used in or in connection with any court process or which is in such a form as may lead the person to whom the same is addressed to believe that the same is a form of court process or that the same emanates from or is issued or used with the authority of a court.”
