A BILL

To amend the Vagrancy Act, 1902.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Vagrancy (Amendment) Act, 1927." Short title.

2. The Vagrancy Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 74, 1902.

(a) by inserting in subsection one of section four next after paragraph (i) the following new paragraph :— Sec. 4 (f).

(j) habitually consorts with reputed thieves or prostitutes or persons who have no visible lawful means of support ; cf. N.Z. Act, No. 146, 1908, s. 49 (e).
