A BILL

To amend section fifty-seven of the Weights and Measures Act, 1915, in certain respects.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act, 1931." Short title.

2. The Weights and Measures Act, 1915, as amended by the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act, 1916, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (ol) of section fifty-seven the words “therein specified”;
- (b) by inserting at the end of section fifty-seven the following new subsections:—

(2) Any regulation purporting to be made under the powers conferred by paragraph (ol) of subsection one of this section may apply—

- (a) generally to all or any class of goods;
- (b) particularly to the goods mentioned in the regulation;
- (c) to all goods other than those mentioned in the regulation.

(3) Subsection two of this section shall be deemed to have been in force since the commencement of the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act, 1916, but shall not operate so as to affect any action or proceeding taken or thing done under the regulation prior to the commencement of the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act, 1931.
