Wentworth Park (Vesting) Bill, 1929.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The object of this Bill is to revoke the dedication of that part of Wentworth Park, Glebe, situated between Bridge-road and the railway viaduct, and to vest the area in His Majesty with a view to it being subdivided and sold by the Crown.

A BILL

To vest in His Majesty certain land at present forming portion of Wentworth Park, and to authorise the sale and disposal of such land; and for purposes connected therewith.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Wentworth Park Short title. (Vesting) Act, 1929."

Vesting and authority to dispose of land under provisions of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913. 2. (1) The land described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby vested in His Majesty, and shall from the commencement of this Act be deemed to be Crown lands within the meaning of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, 5 free from any dedication or trust.

(2) The said land shall be deemed to be land exempt from occupation for residence or business purposes under miner's right or business license and to be temporarily reserved from sale or lease under the 10 Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, and may on revocation of the reserve in accordance with the provisions of that Act be disposed of or otherwise dealt with under the provisions of that Act.

ALL that piece or parcel of land situate in Parish of Petersham, County of Cumberland, containing an area of about 6 acres, commencing at the intersection of the north-eastern side of Park-road with the south-eastern side of Bridge-road and bounded thence by Bridge-road north-easterly to Wattle-street, thence by that street being a 20 curved line and a line bearing south-easterly to the Glebe Island and Darling Island Railway land; thence by the north-western side of that railway land south-westerly to Park-road aforesaid and on the south-west by that road bearing north-westerly to the point of commencement, being the north-western part of Wentworth Park 25 shown upon a plan catalogued Ms. 2280 Sy. in the Department of Lands, Sydney.
