A BILL

To extend the power of the Governor to withdraw land from Western land leases for the purpose of settlement; to amend the Western Lands (Amendment) Act, 1918; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Western Lands Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1925," and shall be read with the Western Lands Act, 1901, as amended by subsequent

2. Section nine of the Western Lands (Amendment) Amendment Act, 1918, is amended by omitting the words "and of Act 1918 situated within the land district of Walgett North."
