# A BILL

To provide that no action, claim, or demand shall lie or be made against the Government of New South Wales, the Railway Commissioners of New South Wales, or other person in respect of the refusal of the said Commissioners during a certain period to supply trucks for the conveyance of wheat or flour, and to provide that any such action pending at, and any such claim or demand made before the commencement of this Act shall cease and abate.

*Wheat Conveyance Indemnity.*

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Wheat Conveyance Indemnity Act, 1919." Short title.

**2.** No action, claim, or demand whatsoever shall lie, or be made, or allowed by, or in favour of, any person whomsoever against His Majesty, or any responsible Minister of the Crown, or the Railway Commissioners of New South Wales, or any officer or any person, for or in respect of any damage, loss, or injury sustained, or alleged to be sustained, by reason of the refusal of the said Commissioners to supply trucks for the conveyance of wheat or flour during the period between the first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and the commencement of this Act, by or under the order or direction of or on behalf of the Government of New South Wales, or any responsible Minister of the Crown; and any such action pending at the commencement of this Act, and any such claim or demand made before the commencement of this Act, shall cease and abate.
