A BILL

WHEREAS by notification published in the Gazette Preamble. on the twenty-fourth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, certain lands described in the Schedule to this Act and included in the boundaries described in the Schedule to the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Act, 1910, were appropriated and resumed for certain public works and purposes and vested in the Minister for Public Works as Constructing Authority 287—

on behalf of His Majesty: And whereas it is desirable to revest such land in William Wilson Killen of "Merribee," Barellan, as of his former estate and interest: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "William Killen

(Murrumbidgee Area) Revesting Act, 1915."

2. The Governor may by proclamation in the Gazette notify that the land described in the Schedule to this Act is, exclusive of appropriated roads, revested in the said William Wilson Killen as of his former estate and interest at the time of the appropriation and resumption aforesaid:

Provided that such estate or interest shall be subject to any trusts, conditions, charges, and obligations affecting the same, which were in existence on or immediately before the said date, and which have not since been fulfilled or discharged, but shall be free from any trusts or dedications created or made after the said date.

3. All such documents may be executed, and all such things may be done as may be thought desirable or necessary in order to revest the land aforesaid in the said William Wilson Killen, in pursuance of this Act.
