Amendment

The Firearms Regulation 1990 is amended by inserting in clause 78(6) after the word "permit" the words "or a junior shooter's target pistol permit".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to mend the Firearms Regulation 1990 to remove the requirement that a fee be paid for the issue of a junior shooter's target pistol permit. Minors are currently exempted from payment of a fee for a firearms permit. Both situations involve the grant to persons below 18 years of age of permits with similiar effect with the only difference being the type of firearm concerned.
