- (b) items 4–7 of Part 2 of Schedule 1;
- (c) Schedule 3 in so far as it amends the following Acts:
 - (i) Bread Act 1969 No. 54;
 - (ii) Factories, Shops and Industries Act 1962 No. 43;
 - (iii) Motor Dealers Act 1974 No. 52;
 - (iv) Travel Agents Act 1986 No. 5.
