The Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Investment Powers Regulation 1990 is amended:

- (a) by omitting from Schedule 2 the matter "Sydney County Council";
- (b) by inserting in Schedule 3 (in alphabetical order of the names of authorities) the following: Sydney Electricity
- (c) by inserting in Schedule 4 (in alphabetical order of the names of authorities) the following:

University of New South Wales

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to confer on Sydney Electricity the investment powers contained in Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987 and to confer on the University of New South Wales the investment powers contained in Part 4 of that Schedule. Currently Sydney Electricity (formerly the Sydney County Council) has the investment powers contained in Part 2 of that Schedule and the University of New South Wales has no investment powers under the Act.
