Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1st April, 1991.

Amendments

- 2. The Community Service Orders Regulation 1988 is amended:
 - (a) by inserting after clause 14 the following clause:

Extension of fine default orders

- 15. (1) For the purposes of section 26H (2) and (3) of the Act:
- (a) an application for the extension of a community service order may be made in Form 9; and.
- (b) an extension of the order may be in Form 10.
- (2) A copy of the extension of a community service order under section 26H of the Act is to be served personally or by post on the person in respect of whom the community service order was made.
- (b) by inserting after Form 8 in Schedule 1 the following forms:
