**Commencement**

1. This Regulation commences on 1 April 1991.

**Amendment**

2. The Workers Compensation (General) Regulation 1987 is amended by omitting item 7 from the Table to clause 9A and by inserting instead the following items:

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to increase, from 1 April 1991, the basic rate of weekly workers compensation by way of income support during the first 26 weeks in the case of workers not covered by awards.
