The object of this Proclamation is to commence those provisions of the Environmental Offences and Penalties (Amendment) Act 1990 which insert section 8G into the Environmental Offences and Penalties Act 1989 (dealing with penalty notices for certain offences) and which repeal section 24C (penalty notices) of the Clean Air Act 1961 and section 32A (penalty notices) of the Clean Waters Act 1970
