The Poisons Regulations are amended:

- (a) by inserting in Regulation 2 in alphabetical order the following definition:

“Director-General” means the Director-General of the Department of Health.
  - (b) by omitting from the Regulations the word “Secretary” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the word “Director-General”.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Poisons Regulations so as to remove inconsistencies in references to the head of the Department of Health.
