EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to replace a reference to the State Drug Crime Commission with a reference to the New South Wales Crime Commission. The Proclamation is consequential on the State Drug Crime Commission (Amendment) Act 1990 which renamed the State Drug Crime Commission as the New South Wales Crime Commission.
