LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1919—ORDINANCE

(Relating to licences for advertising structures)

Commencement

1. This Ordinance commences on 1 August, 1991.

Amendment

2. Ordinance No. 55 under the Local Government Act 1919 is amended by omitting clause 7 (2) (h) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:

- (h) the period in respect of which the licence is applied for (being a period in whole years that is not more than 5 years).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Ordinance amends Ordinance No. 55 (Regulation of Advertisements and Structures Used for the Display of Advertisements). Under that Ordinance an applicant for a licence in respect of an advertising structure is required to specify in the application the period (in years) for which the licence is being sought. That period at present is a period of 3, 4 or 5 years. The object of this Ordinance is to provide that a licence may also be sought for a period of one or two years.
