

**BUILDING SERVICES CORPORATION ACT 1989—
REGULATION**

(Relating to the BSC Comprehensive Insurance Scheme)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 4 February 1991.

Amendment

2. The Building Services Corporation Regulation 1990 is amended:
 - (a) by omitting from clause 6 (1) (a) of Form 4 in Schedule 1 the matter “\$60,000” and by inserting instead the matter “\$100,000”;
 - (b) by omitting from clause 6 (2) (c) of Form 4 in Schedule 1 (as inserted by clause 5 of the Regulation made under the Building Services Corporation Act 1989 and published in Gazette No. 174 of 21 December 1990 at page 11209) the matter “\$60,000” and by inserting instead the matter “\$100,000”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Building Services Corporation Regulation 1990 to increase (from \$60,000 to \$100,000) the maximum aggregate liability for which the Corporation is liable under the BSC Comprehensive Insurance Scheme in relation to a single dwelling or a defective kit home.
