TRAFFIC ACT 1909—REGULATION

(Relating to the wearing of protective helmets by persons
travelling on motor cycles)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 January 1992.

Amendment

2. The Motor Traffic Regulations 1935 are amended:
 - (a) by omitting Regulation 110E (2)–(10) and by inserting instead the following clause:
 - (2) Clauses (1) and (1A) do not apply to any person who is travelling in an enclosed hard-top cabin attached to, and forming part of, a motor tricycle.
 - (b) by omitting items 31 and 32 from Schedule A.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Motor Traffic Regulations 1935 so as to require that a protective helmet be worn by all riders of motor cycles and all passengers on motor cycles (other than passengers being carried in an enclosed had-top cabin). Previously, certain exemptions (for example, on medical grounds) were available.

The Regulation also makes a consequential amendment.
