The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain amendments to the Supreme Court Act 1970 the District Court Act 1973 and the Local Courts (Civil Claims) Act 1970. The amendments relate to interest on damages, the interim payment of damages and the liability of a solicitor for costs in the Supreme and District Courts and also increase the limit on a Local Court's civil jurisdiction.
