**STATE AUTHORITIES NON-CONTRIBUTORY  
SUPERANNUATION ACT 1987—REGULATION**

(Relating to determining the eligible service of employees in order to  
calculate their benefits under the Act)

The State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Regulation 1988 is amended:

- (a) by inserting in the definition of “leave without pay” in clause 8 (5) before the word “means” the words “, in relation to an employee,”;
  - (b) by inserting in the definition of “prescribed leave in clause 8 (5) before the word “means” the words “, in relation to an employee,”;
  - (c) by omitting from clause 8 (5) the word “contributor”, wherever occurring, and by inserting instead the word “employee”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to change references in clause 8 (5) of the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Regulation 1988 from “contributor” to “employee”. This is necessary because employees to whom the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987 applies do not contribute towards the benefits payable to them under that Act.
