Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 23 September 1991.

Amendment

2. The Justices (Penalty Notices) Regulation 1984 is amended by omitting from clause 6 the matter "\$25" and by inserting instead the matter "\$35".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Justices Act 1902 provides for the enforcement of penalties in relation to certain minor offences in the local courts jurisdiction through an administrative scheme (Self-Enforcing Infringement Notice Scheme).

The object of this Regulation is to increase the fee for the filing of a certificate that enables an enforcement order to be made for the purposes of the Scheme.
