(Relating to the holding of sweeps and calcuttas in connection with certain sporting events)

The Lotteries and Games of Chance Regulations 1966 are amended:

- (a) by inserting at the end of Regulation 10 (c) the following word and paragraph:

- (d) each greyhound-racing event named in Column 1 of Part 4 of the Table to this clause and conducted by the organisation named in Column 2 of that Part opposite the name of that event,
- (b) by inserting after Part 3 of the Table to Regulation 10 the following Part:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Lotteries and Games of Chance Regulations 1966 so as to permit the holding of sweeps and calcuttas in connection with a greyhound race called the "Tooheys Maiden" conducted by the Dapto Agricultural and Horticultural Greyhound Racing Club.
