

OPTOMETRISTS ACT 1930—REGULATION

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 28 September 1991.

Amendments

2. The Optometrists Regulations 1965 are amended:
 - (a) by omitting from Regulation 14 (1) (b) the matter "\$105" and by inserting instead the matter "\$110";
 - (b) by omitting from Regulation 23 the matter "\$80" and by inserting instead the matter "\$110";
 - (c) by omitting from Regulation 25 the matter "\$160" and by inserting instead the matter "\$220".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to increase the fee for an application for registration as an optometrist, the annual roll fee payable by registered-optometrists and the fee for the restoration of a name to the register of optometrists.
