Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 30 September 1991.

Amendments

- 2. The Poisons Regulations are amended:
- (a) by omitting from Regulation 49 (3) (b) the matter "\$315" and by inserting instead the matter "\$330";
- (b) by omitting from Regulation 51 (3) (c) the matter "\$155" and by inserting instead the matter "\$165".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to increase the application fees payable for licences to supply drugs of addiction and fees payable for licences to manufacture and supply such drugs.

The increases do not affect the fees payable by public institutions or charitable organisations.
