- (a) by omitting from Regulation 10 (b) and (c) the word "clause" wherever occurring and by inserting instead the word "Regulation";
- (b) by omitting from Regulation 10 (c) the matter "or 3" and by inserting instead the matter ", 3 or 4";
- (c) by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of Part 1 of the Table to Regulation 10, in alphabetical order, the following matter:

(d) by inserting after Part 3 of the Table to Regulation 10 the following Part:

Part 4—Foot racing events

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Lotteries and Games of Chance Regulations 1966 so as to permit the holding of sweeps and calcuttas in connection with certain additional sporting events.
