Commencement

1. This Ordinance commences on 4 December 1991.

Amendment

- **2.** Ordinance No. 73 under the Local Government Act 1919 is amended:
 - (a) by inserting in clause 1 under the heading *Cities and Municipalities*, in alphabetical order, the words "Bathurst (City)";
 - (b) by inserting in clause 1 under the heading *Shires*, in alphabetical order, the word "Culcairn".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 73 (which relates to the installation of domestic-type oil and solid fuel heaters) so as to extend the application of the Ordinance to the City of Bathurst and the Shire of Culcairn.
