### UNIVERSITY OF NEW ENGLAND ACT 1989—BY-LAW

(Relating to the revision of the By-laws of network members of the University and of Orange Agricultural College, and to courses, assessments and awards and regulation of traffic)

The Board of Governors of the University of New England, in pursuance of the University of New England Act 1989, hereby makes the By-law set forth hereunder:

# Amendment of Northern Rivers College of Advanced Education By-law

- **1.** The Northern Rivers College of Advanced Education Bylaw is amended:
  - (a) by inserting after clause 1.2 the following clause:
    - 1.2A The By-laws of the University of New England apply to the University of New England, Northern Rivers to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this By-law.
  - (b) by omitting Chapters 11, 12, 14, 15 and 16.

# Amendment of Armidale College of Advanced Education By-law

- **2.** The Armidale College of Advanced Education By-law is amended:
  - (a) by inserting after clause 2 of Chapter 1 the following clause:
    - 2A. The By-laws of the University of New England apply to the University of New England, Armidale to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this By-law.
  - (b) by omitting Chapters 6 and 15 and the matter relating to those Chapters in clause 3 of Chapter 1.

# Amendment of Orange Agricultural College By-law 1984

- 3. The Orange Agricultural College By-law 1984 is amended:
- (a) by inserting after clause 2 the following clause:
  - 2A. The By-laws of the University of New England apply to the Orange Agricultural College to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this By-law.
- (b) by omitting Chapter 15 and the matter relating to that Chapter in clause 3 of Chapter 1.

### Amendment of By-laws of University of New England

- **4.** The By-laws of the University of New England are amended:
- (a) by omitting By-law No. 16 and by inserting instead the following By-law:

# BY-LAW No. 16—Regulation of Traffic

The Board may make rules for regulating, or providing for the regulation of, traffic on any land of the University, including:

- (a) the driving, parking and using of vehicles on any such land; and
- (b) the payment of such fees and charges as the Board considers necessary to be paid in respect of the driving, parking and using of vehicles on any such land; and
- (c) the imposition and payment of penalties for parking and traffic infringements.
- (b) by inserting after By-law No. 18 the following By-law: BY-LAW No. 19—Courses, Assesment and Awards

The Board may make rules for regulating or providing for the regulation of:

- (a) the requirements for courses of study; and
- (b) the conduct of examinations and other forms of assessment; and
- (c) the requirements for the award of fellowships, scholarships, prizes, bursaries and other academic awards.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this By-law is to repeal various provisions of the By-laws applying to network members of the University of New England and to the Orange Agricultural College relating to the following matters:

- (a) academic dress;
- (b) halls of residence and residential colleges;
- (c) education and research establishments;
- (d) management of property;
- (e) college unions;
- (f) examinations—progessions;
- (g) courses of study.

Those matters will now be covered by the By-laws of the University of New England.

In addition, the By-laws of the University of New England are amended to revise the provisions dealing with traffic matters to bring them into line with the University of New England Act 1989 and to enable rules to be made by the Board of Governors of the University with respect to courses of study, examinations, assessments and academic awards.
