

**NURSES REGISTRATION ACT 1953—REGULATION**

(Relating to fees)

**Amendments to commence on 1 January 1992**

1. (1) This clause commences on 1 January 1992.
- (2) The Nurses Registration Regulations are amended:
  - (a) by omitting from Regulation 33 (c) the matter “45” and by inserting instead the matter “50”;
  - (b) by omitting from Regulation 33 (d) and (h) the matter “24” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “32”;
  - (c) by omitting from Regulation 33 (g) and (t) the matter “34” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “42”;
  - (d) by omitting from Regulation 33 (i) and (k) the matter “16” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “20”;
  - (e) by omitting from Regulation 33 (o) the matter “6” and by inserting instead the matter “10”;
  - (f) by omitting from Regulation 33 (p) the matter “11” and by inserting instead the matter “12”;
  - (g) by omitting from Regulation 33 (q) and (s) the matter “11” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “15”.

**Amendments to commence on 1 February 1992**

2. (1) This clause commences on 1 February 1992.

(2) The Nurses Registration Regulations are further amended by omitting from Regulation 33 (b), (e) and (i) the matter “34” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “42”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to increase certain of the fees payable under the Nurses Registration Act 1953. The fees that are being increased include nurses' registration fees, nurses' enrolment fees and nurses' practising fees.
