EXPLANATORY NOTE

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to require any person who is the holder of both a driver's licence and a motor cycle rider's licence to pay a separate fee for the issue or renewal of each licence (abolishing a scheme in force at present under which the second licence is obtained free of charge); and
- (b) to reduce (from \$12 to \$10) the fee payable for the issue of a duplicate or replacement learner's licence.
