This Proclamation commences the Miscellaneous Acts (Public Health) Repeal and Amendment Act 1990 to repeal the Public Health Act 1902 and the Acts which amended it as well as certain related Acts and to make several amendments (mainly of cross-references) as a consequence of the commencement on 18 November 1991 of the Public Health Act 1991, and the earlier commencement of the Unhealthy Building Land Act 1990.
