

NURSING HOMES ACT 1988—REGULATION

(Relating to fees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 13th December, 1991.

Amendments

2. The Nursing Homes Regulation 1990 is amended:
 - (a) by omitting from clause 5 (b) the matter “\$480” and by inserting instead the matter “\$510”;
 - (b) by omitting the table to clause 7 and by inserting instead the following table:
