Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 January 1992.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this Regulation is to amend the General Traffic Regulations 1916 so as to remove all exemptions to the requirement that a person is not to ride a bicycle on a public street, nor travel as a passenger on it, unless the person is wearing an approved protective helmet on his or her head.
