EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the Film and Video Tape Classification (Amendment) Act 1991.

Section 2 (2) of the Act backdated the commencement of Schedule 1 (9)–(11) to the Act (relating to the date a classification decision of the censor or the appeal censor takes effect) to 1 January 1991. The remaining provisions are to commence on 1 January 1992.
