Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 March 1991.

Amendment

2. The Jury Regulation 1977 is amended by omitting from clause 8 the matter "\$100" and by inserting instead the words "2 penalty units".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Jury Regulation 1977 to increase, from \$100 to 2 penalty units (i.e. \$200), the penalty for failure to attend for jury service if dealt with by the penalty notice procedure under section 64 of the Jury Act 1977.
