Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period during which Ministerial exemptions from provisions of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* may be made in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic.

This Regulation is made under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, including sections 10.13 (the general regulation-making power) and 10.17 (definition of *prescribed period*).
