Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are—

- (a) to postpone the dates on which special statutory provisions enacted in response to the COVID-19 pandemic are repealed, and
- (b) to extend the periods during which special statutory provisions enacted in response to the COVID-19 pandemic have effect.

This Regulation is made under the following Acts—

- (a) Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012, including section 54(2)(b),
- (b) Children (Community Service Orders) Act 1987, including the definition of **prescribed period** in sections 9A(3) and 14A(3),

- (c) Children (Detention Centres) Act 1987, including the definition of **prescribed period** in section 110(5),
- (d) Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2013, including the definition of **prescribed period** in clause 22 of Schedule 1,
- (e) Court Security Act 2005, including section 12H(b),
- (f) Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999, including the definition of prescribed period in section 274,
- (g) Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Act 2007, including the definition of **prescribed period** in section 29(5),
- (h) Criminal Procedure Act 1986, including section 367(b),
- (i) Electronic Transactions Act 2000, including section 18(b),
- (j) Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Act 1998, including the definition of **prescribed period** in section 22C(9),
- (k) Jury Act 1977, including section 25(6)(b),
- (l) Sheriff Act 2005, including the definition of **prescribed period** in section 7C(14).

This Regulation is made with the agreement of—

- (a) the Minister for Counter Terrorism and Corrections, being the Minister administering the *Crimes* (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999, and
- (b) the Minister for Families, Communities and Disability Services, being the Minister administering the following Acts—
 - (i) Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012,
 - (ii) Children (Community Service Orders) Act 1987,
 - (iii) Children (Detention Centres) Act 1987.
