Roads Amendment (Evidentiary Certificates) Regulation 2022

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are as follows—

- (a) to allow a person who is authorised by TfNSW to issue legally admissible evidentiary certificates for matters relating to motor vehicles using tollways or the payment of tolls,
- (b) to update references to the relevant Minister and Department.

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including sections 248 and 264, the general regulation making power.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Roads Amendment (Evidentiary Certificates) Regulation 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Roads Regulation 2018

[1] Clauses 72 and 73

Omit “NSW Land Registry Services” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “Department of Planning and Environment – Crown Lands”.

[2] Clause 74 Authority to enter land

Omit “Minister for Lands and Forestry” and “Department of Industry” from clause 74(a).

Insert instead “Minister administering the *Crown Land Management Act 2016*” and “Department of Planning and Environment”, respectively.

[3] Clause 75

Omit the clause. Insert instead—

75 Evidentiary certificates

- (1) For the Act, section 248(1), (2) and (4), the following classes of persons are prescribed—
 - (a) in relation to a certificate issued on behalf of the Minister administering the *Crown Land Management Act 2016*—a Public Service senior executive employed in the Department of Planning and Environment,
 - (b) in relation to a certificate issued on behalf of a council—the general manager of the council,
 - (c) in relation to a certificate issued on behalf of TfNSW—a person employed in the Transport Service who is authorised by TfNSW to issue the certificate.
- (2) For the Act, section 248(5) in relation to a certificate issued on behalf of TfNSW, a person employed in the Transport Service who is authorised by TfNSW to issue the certificate is prescribed.
