Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to facilitate the transfer of prosecutorial functions from Transport for NSW to the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator established under the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (NSW)*, section 656, including by declaring that officers and employees of the Regulator are public officers for the purposes of the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Criminal Procedure Amendment (National Heavy Vehicle Regulator) Regulation 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 August 2022.

3 Amendment of Criminal Procedure Regulation 2017

(1) Clause 113 Public officers

Insert after clause 113(1)(h)—

- (i) the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator.

(2) Schedule 3 NSW Government agencies and statutory bodies required to pay court fees

Omit the matter relating to Transport for NSW.

Insert in alphabetical order—

National Heavy Vehicle Regulator, but only in relation to offences against the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (NSW)*

Transport for NSW, but only in relation to offences against the *Marine Safety Act 1998* or the regulations made under that Act
