Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* that—

- (a) remove limits on the provision of taxi services to specified areas of operation, and
- (b) cancel all remaining existing licences to provide taxi services, and
- (c) end the transitional period, established by the Act, Schedule 2, Part 3, during which taxi licence applications were only able to be granted to the holders of existing licences.
