

Work Health and Safety Amendment (Notification of Silicosis Cases and Deaths) Regulation 2024

Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to remove the requirement for the Secretary of the Ministry of Health to report information about silicosis cases and deaths to SafeWork NSW. This regulation is made under the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*, section 271B(3)(b).

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1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Work Health and Safety Amendment (Notification of Silicosis Cases and Deaths) Regulation 2024.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.
