# Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Prescription Database) Regulation 2024

under the

Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following regulation under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*.

## Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* to allow the Secretary of the Ministry of Health to enter into an agreement with a person to engage another person to operate and maintain a database to record and monitor data about monitored medicines and substances.

This regulation is made under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*, section 45C, the general regulation-making power.

## **Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Prescription Database) Regulation 2024**

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### **1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Prescription Database) Regulation 2024*.

### **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

## **Schedule 1      Amendment of Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008**

**[1]    Clause 174C Establishment and purpose of database**

Omit clause 174C(2). Insert instead—

- (2)    The Secretary may enter into an agreement with the following to operate and maintain the database—
  - (a)    a person,
  - (b)    a person who engages another person to operate and maintain the database.

**[2]    Clause 174C(3)**

Omit “The database operator”.

Insert instead “The persons referred to in subclause (2)(a) or (b)”.
